Regional strategies for CleanSky2

- The region will promote investments in aerospace, based on regional companies and organization's challenges and other areas that are prioritized by CS2.
- The region will be active to influence funds regarding this areas. E.g. ESIF as well as others funds, both national and international.
- An important prerequisite is that development project/Ideas follows the regional smart specialization strategy.







The region's smart specialisation areas:



- Effective logistics
- Business models and arenas for sustainable system solutions
- Smart, secure and robust connected products and systems
- Simulation and visualisation
- Advanced materials

Each of them, or several together, contributes to building strength in a number of our successful industries. Smart specialisation is a method, a way of working to prioritise development projects that strengthen companies and thereby the region's competitiveness.

- Work together for the identification of common priorities to both entities and to identify potential synergies between funding instruments and framework
- Work together for the identification of synergies among programmes
- Establish a monitoring and follow-up system of the actions carried out under the framework of the Regional Innovation Strategy for smart specialisation
