Introduction to the ATI

- The ATI Programme represents a £3.9 billion joint government and industry investment managed by the ATI, Innovate UK and BEIS.
- **Two key areas of work:**
 - Setting the strategy for UK civil aerospace R&T
 - Selecting projects to fund and overseeing the portfolio

- Applicants are expected to develop projects that have strong market potential for the UK and Sweden and applications must be guided by the respective aerospace strategies of the UK and Sweden: Accelerating Ambition and NRIA Flyg.

I. SCOPE

The UK and Sweden are announcing a joint funding call for aerospace R&D projects under the EUREKA Network Projects programme. Applicants are expected to develop project proposals which have strong market potential for the UK and Sweden. Project proposals must demonstrate alignment to the respective national aerospace strategies of the applicants:
